It was a privilege to see students getting the reward for their application under the expert guidance of Fitzharrys staff. After a challenging start to secondary school in 2019-20, this year group have shown great drive, resilience, positivity, knowledge, and understanding. The outcomes of this were clear today and it was pleasure to see Fitzharrys students smiling as they prepare for their next steps.

Among a range of successes were Alice, Megan, Charlotte, Chloe, Emily, and Lily who all did superbly. Lily, Charlotte, and Megan all received 9 or more grades at 7-9. Alife and Adam also did brilliantly, pictured below with Maths teacher Mr Poolman. Alfie received 9 GCSEs at grade 7-9, Adam received 7 at grade 7-9. Kimberley (9 grade 7-9) and Fritha (7 grade 7-9) also excelled. These students were among many who were celebrating in the main hall, with 70% of students gaining a 4 or higher in both English and Maths.

Over half of this cohort will join JMF6, our shared sixth form, to study A levels and other level 3 qualifications, while other students will head off to other post-16 education and apprenticeships.
