Dear Parents/Carers

In the summer term we organise a 'Fitzactive Week' where all students are off timetable in order to experience a wealth of opportunities to develop their personal attributes. All of the Year 7 students attend a 3-day compulsory residential camp at Youlbury to challenge themselves and improve their personal and social skills within a small team.

Details of this year's trip can be found below:

Location	Youlbury Scout Activity Centre and Farmoor Reservoir
Date	Wednesday 9th – Friday 11th July 2025 Arrive at Fitzharrys School normal time on the Wednesday and return for 3.15pm on the Friday
Travel arrangements	Students will walk to or from the campsite at Youlbury. They will also travel in coaches between activity sites and school.
Activities	Students will take part in a selection of the following activities: Activities at Youlbury 3G swing, Abseiling, Climbing Wall, Tomahawk, Jacobs Ladder, Crate Stacking, Aerial Trek, Zip line, Archery Watersports at Farmoor reservoir Sailing, Standup paddleboarding, Raft building
Other details	Students will need to be able to pack their belongings in to one rucksack that they must be able to carry themselves for the 3 mile walk to or from the campsite. Sleeping bags and tents should be clearly named and will be transported by vehicle to the campsite. Food is being provided by the Fitzharrys catering team and is factored into the price. This includes breakfast, lunch and dinner.
Tent details	Students who have their own waterproof tents for 3-4 people are encouraged to bring them. The school have a number of tents that can be hired for the school camp for £1 per person. Please contact the Year 7 team BEFORE buying a tent for this

The cost of the trip will be £150 per student which can be paid in 4 instalments at the end of January, February, March and April. Payments will be taken via parent mail on the following dates:
